We met in 2009 when Andrea


went to Nicaragua

We love spending time in our modest home, which we have slowly been remodeling and adding on to, making it our own.




We love taking Zacai to We love taking Lacai to trampoline parks, discovering new city parks, and riding new city parks, and riding bikes along the river.


Niko is our 5 year old German Shepherd-Husky. He is very playful and energetic, but also very sweet and cuddly. He loves walks and playing with other dogs.






Niko and Zacai are best buddies! They have grown up together and are so sweet with each other.






A few things Orlando loves about Andrea:









Fall


